- IV. Treasurer Report
  - a. Financial update
    - i. As the treasurer was not in attendance the financial update was presented verbally utilizing the report from March 2nd. Mr. Harper reported that the only unusual expenditure that had occurred since March was a \$4,512 payment to the home owner's association for reimbursement associated with rehabilitation and cleaning of the entry to the neighborhood, also he reported that appropriate reports had been submitted to the Legislative Auditor as required annually.

a. Status of Maintenance of the Common Areas

- i. It was noted that the regular maintenance of common areas was occurring through the Homeowners association.
- ii. The status of the rehabilitation of the pavilion was discussed. Also discussed was the need additional signage at the entry, especially the need of a sign stating a crime camera is being utilized and giving credit to the various parties that had paid for it. It was explained that the work being done was through a cooperative endeavor with the Homeowners association. There was also some discussion about the need for a no peddling allowed sign at the entry.

b. Additional projects to neighborhood, landscaping, signage etc.

c. Discussion of driver feedback signs

- i. Mr Harper stated that he had met with representatives of City Parish concerning the installation of driver feedback speed signs. He reported that he requested, on behalf of the District, the City Parish loan a temporary sign to evaluate the possibility of acquiring one or more for speed control. Speed humps were also discussed


VII. New Business
